SCRIPTURE READING REFLECTION

In today's first reading we find that the first Christians felt so compelled by God's word in the Scriptures (here Psalm 109 v 6: context: Satan meeting out justice to a high official - believed by the Jews to have David as the human author) that they deemed it necessary to replace the position left vacant by Judas Iscariot. Today's Gospel is taken from the final prayer of Jesus for his disciples. And so He prays: "Consecrate them in truth; Your word is truth." Elsewhere in his Gospel, St. John reports Jesus saying: "I am the way, the truth and the life." Still elsewhere St. John begins his Gospel by telling us that God's Word became incarnate (took on human flesh) in Jesus. The Church has always recognized this interplay between the Incarnate Word and the inspired word in the Scriptures. Words are meant to communicate realities beyond themselves. Modern spiritual advisers keep telling us that we need to develop a personal relationship with Jesus, God's Word. Can we expect to do so if we remain ignorant of God's word in the Scriptures?
