**Father

Trinity Sunday

Whenever we try to love another, inevitably we wish and try to get to know that someone better. Also, inevitably, we sooner or later realize in that endeavor that we are dealing with a mystery of the other. The more we think we know the other, the more we realize that we don't really know the other, but rather are only scratching the surface. The analogy often used is that it is like peeling an onion; we no sooner remove one layer than we find another. When it comes to loving God, we have a real problem, in fact, an unsolvable one. We are creatures with all sorts of limitations trying to perceive another (notice I didn't say someone because we are dealing with another Who is both three and one) who is limitless, timeless, and our Creator. Yet, He being infinite love has freely chosen to reveal to us who He is! Today we celebrate the Holy Trinity. We do so with a clear realization of how little we can grasp, yet with joyful gratitude that God offers us a view.

This week our second collection will be for the **Church in Central and Eastern Europe**.
