SCRIPTURE READING REFLECTION

*In today's second reading from 2nd
 Corinthians, the context is a collection
 from the Corinthians sponsored by Paul
 for the needy in Jerusalem. Paul quotes
 a passage from the story of the mana
 provided by God during the people's
 historical sojourn in the desert, as related
 in the book of Exodus 16:18. In that story,
 no matter how much mana each one
 gathered, miraculously each one always
 wound up with enough. As expressed in
 today's reading: "Whoever had much did
 not have more, and whoever had little did
 not have less." It is worth serious reflection
 that in the spiritual life of union with
 Christ, the one who gives in charity benefits
 equally with the one who is the recipient of
 that charity. This is the point St. Paul is
 trying to make in saying that each one fills
 what is lacking in the other. We moderns
 tend to think that psychological satisfaction
 is the reward for generosity. That clearly
 is a fallacy. The real reward is growth in
 grace, for which psychologically feeling
 good about it, is irrelevant.*
